CTPR 409 has shifted from working on shows within a studio to providing students the opportunity to produce their own segments that they have spent all semester writing and developing! Students now develop their own television show concept and see it come to life on the Trojan Vision platform! Our spectacular faculty works closely with our students to help guide them into learning about the foundations of television production. In class, we learned how to write scripts, direct a segment, become a technical director, design our own graphics and overlays, cast and work with actors, and edit videos. This unique experience was all possible through StreamYard. StreamYard is an online platform that provides students and faculty the opportunity to produce their shows as if they are in a Master Control Room.

Our current students have been working all semester to develop great shows that range from cooking to late-night news, to games! The possibilities are endless with what you can develop in this class! Although this is recorded remotely, students still have a great opportunity in producing their own segments and shows that they have always dreamed of!
